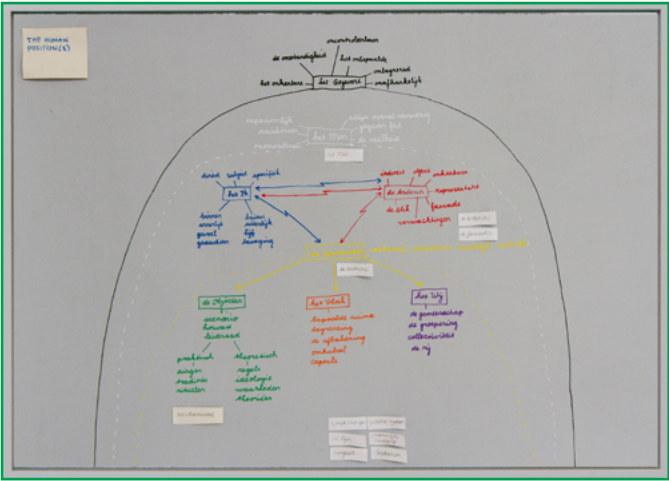


LOGO

In addition to addressing black, this year, following last year's position, we have created our own green together. Since a few months we call ourselves 'Alle maten.' A name we chose together. And Philip (member 39), using our input from the results of our decision tree created our logo with the name that you saw at the beginning. Next to the decision tree is a video on which Philip and I explain in 2 minutes the steps we took to arrive at our own green together. For a logo is part of the green. Or in other words: the Objects. They are that which connects us. Think of a flag, a song or a uniform. And thus also a logo and a name. An attempt to collectively give shape to our connection.



THE (BASIC)CONSTRUCTION

The (basic)Construction with the eight figures (from l.t.r. the Given, the Mass, the I, the Other(s), the Constructions, the Objects, the Plane, the We). Each year we stand still at one of the figures and contemplate on it with a corresponding standpoint. Standpoint 1 (2021) was: *Keep moving from white to blue.* Standpoint 2 (2022) was: *Choose the corresponding green (with your blue) deliberately.* At the speakers, you can listen to the reflection of Judith (member 43) on the white and Lotte (member 47) on the green, which they recited during the meeting.

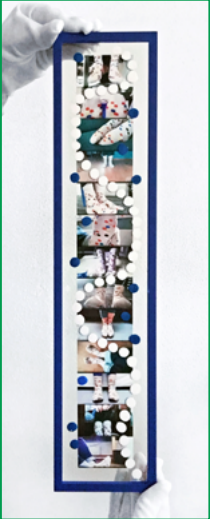

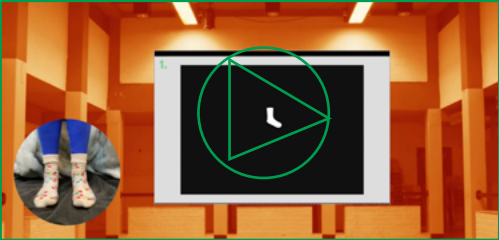
TWO PENNANTS

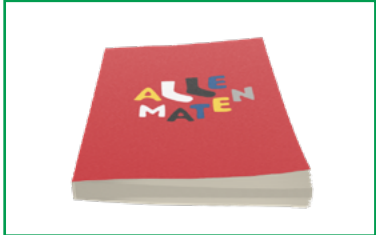

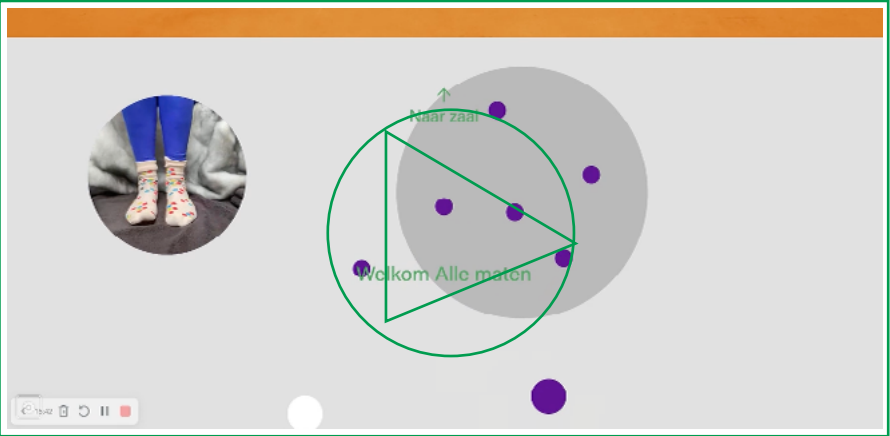
